 - New German Bilingual Program
 - Piloted at some schools last year, and will be coming to our school this year.
 - A group of parents that will meet 4-5 times
 - Focus on making a five year plan
 - Eco-School program Tessier and Buckner
 - The final two smartboards have arrived.
- OurSCHOOL survey results we discussed.
 - Meike shared slides and information
 - Grade 4/5 & 6 students answer a series of questions on mental health, friendships, school life, home life, etc. The do this questionnaire in the Fall, and then the exact same students answer the exact same questions in the Spring of that same year
 - o Compared to last year the numbers are looking pretty good
 - One area of concern last year was the grade four female cohort. That same group is now in grade five, and still an area of concern
 - What are we doing to support this group?
